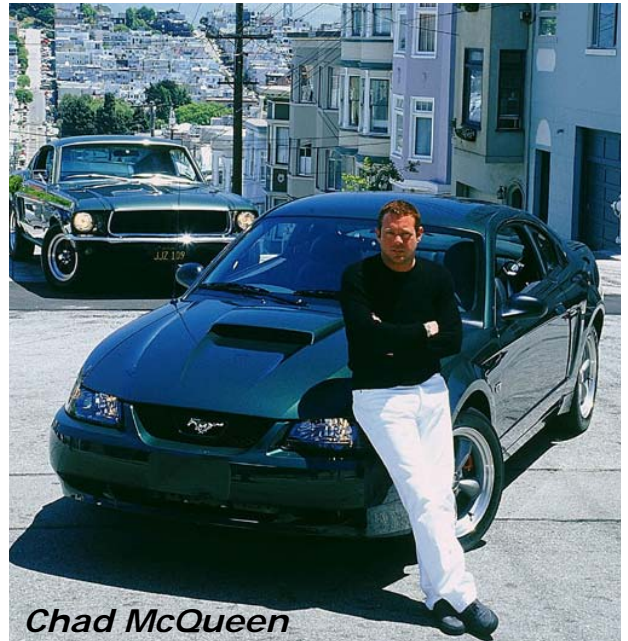
FOR A GOOD CAUSE

The Ford Mustang Bullitt program started in 2001, with the special edition Mustang that would honor the 1968 Mustang Fastback featured in the 1968 movie **Bullitt**, that featured Steve McQueen in the role of SFPD Lt. Frank Bullitt. At the end of the movie, arguably the greatest car chase scene takes place through the streets of San Francisco. Ford's Bullitt has become one of the most popular late model Mustangs available.
