Show Criteria

To enter your vehicle:

You must first choose which class to enter. This is determined by two things:

1. The year, make, and model of your vehicle
2. Whether it is completely stock or modified in any way

Please review the table of **CATEGORIES & CLASSES** on the page to the right. If you select a **FACTORY STOCK** class, please read the **Factory Stock Class Criteria** stated below. If your vehicle is modified in any way, you will have to determine the extent of your vehicle's modifications to select either a **PERSONALIZED** or **MODIFIED** class. Please read and follow the **Personalized & Modified Class Criteria** stated below.

PLEASE NOTE: Vehicles that are entered in incorrect classes could be disqualified without notice.

FACTORY STOCK — Class Criteria

The **Factory Stock** categories are designed for the owner of any vehicle whose objective is to maintain the vehicle in its original condition. The vehicle should reflect what would have been found in a dealer's showroom when sold new, including any authorized dealer options. The vehicle will be judged on originality, condition, and cleanliness. Your vehicle must have *zero* modifications points to be eligible for entry in a Factory Stock class. **Entry in Factory Stock classes is by pre-registration only.** Vehicles which meet the Factory Stock criteria can be entered in either the **Factory Stock** or **Personalized** categories of classes.

IMPORTANT: Please read the criteria below, and enter the class that is appropriate for your Mustang. It is **YOUR** responsibility to register your Mustang in the proper category/class. Any Mustangs entered in Factory Stock classes, which do not meet the criteria below, may be disqualified. The Chief Judge's decisions are final.

Allowable exceptions include:

- Non-original battery.
- Mechanical replacement parts, as long as they are still of OEM type, such as: starters, oil filters, air filters, belts, hoses, mufflers, and suspension components.
- Radio may be of replacement type, only if intended for original dashboard opening, and dashboard is not altered.
- Addition of options that could have been ordered from the factory/dealer, that are still of OEM type/quality.
- Radial tires, if size and appearance reflect OEM type.

Non-allowable exceptions include:

- Paint that is not an original Mustang color or non-acrylic paint (must match the paint code on the vehicle's data plate).
- Addition of aftermarket audio/video systems.
- Antennas that are not of OEM type/quality.
- Steering wheel that is not of OEM type/quality.
- Aftermarket engine dress-up kit.
- Braided hoses, colored spark plug wires, or other non-original engine modifications.
- Body modifications of any kind.
- Tires that are not like OEM type (wrong size).
- Wheels/wheel covers that are not OEM type/quality.
- Trunk not in original condition.
- Interior changes from OEM condition (wrong color, wrong seat covering, wrong upholstery).
- Chrome parts that are not as original.

These criteria are provided as general guidelines only and may not include all of the allowable or non-allowable exceptions. The final determination regarding qualification to enter the Factory Stock classes will be made by the designated judging representative, based on the common club guidelines. PERSONALIZED & MODIFIED — Class Criteria

Please review the following tables of modifications, and match the associated point values with the modifications on your vehicle. Add up the points associated with each modification, and your total will determine whether your vehicle should be placed in a **Personalized** or **Modified** class. A total of *65 points or less* will place your vehicle in a **Personalized** class, and a total of *more than 65 points* places your vehicle in a **Modified** class. **Be sure to select the correct class for your vehicle (from the Categories & Classes table on the page to the right), and lastly but most importantly, be sure to indicate your points total on your entry form.**
